



Zodiac Aerospace press release

Plaisir, July 11, 2010 – During its meeting held on 9 July 2010, the Supervisory Board of Zodiac Aerospace considered a letter dated 6 July 2010, sent by the President of the Management Board of Safran to the President of the Supervisory Board of Zodiac Aerospace and proposing an industrial combination of the two groups (without any reference to a price or an exchange ratio for Zodiac Aerospace shares). The Supervisory Board, after hearing notably the presentation of the Management Board on the industrial content of the project, unanimously decided not to pursue this project.

Zodiac Aerospace is a world leader in aerospace equipment and systems, intended for commercial, regional, and business aircrafts, as well as helicopters and space. Zodiac Aerospace has 19,000 employees worldwide and generated revenues of € 2.2 billion in 2008/2009, through its three business segments: Aerosafety & Technology, Aircraft Systems and Cabin Interiors.
